Daniela Nováčková is Professor at the Faculty of Management, Comenius University in Bratislava. Prof. JUDr. Daniela Nováčková is guarantor of the Study Program „International Management”. She specialises in European Economic Law. During the pre-accession phase of the Slovakia’s EU membership, she was active member of Slovak negotiation teams and participated at the transposition of EC/EU Directives into the Slovak legislation which were in scope of the Ministry of Finance of the Slovak Republic. During this period, she was an intern in several EU institutions (Luxembourg, Brussels). She is a co-author of several Slovak legislation bills (draft laws), inter alia the bill on the state aid (in 1999). She applied her expertise in international contract law in negotiation, conclusion, and adaptation of bilateral investment contracts between the Slovak Republic and other countries. She proved her expertise in European law and European affairs when she was appointed in 2003 as the first authorised forensic expert of the Ministry of Judiciary of the Slovak Republic in the field „Legal Relations to Outland – European Law “. In the application legal practice, she has been dealing with the state aid issues.
