The selection of manuscripts using the "double blind" peer review system

The manuscripts received for publication at **ADJURIS** – **International Academic Publisher** will be revised using the "*double blind" peer review* system, respecting international standards of scientific books. Thus, any manuscript submitted for publication will be reviewed by at least two reviewers with a national and international reputation in social sciences. The review will be done on an anonymous basis (author's name is not communicated to the reviewers; reviewers name is not communicated to the author). If is necessary, the authors will receive recommendations and observations to improve the quality of their paper's content. It is possible to refuse publication of the manuscript to the proposal made by reviewers.

In conducting the evaluation, the reviewers will take into account the provisions of **COPE Ethical Guidelines for Peer Reviewers** published by *Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE)*. Following the evaluation, reviewers can recommend: publication of the manuscript, publication of the manuscript only if it will be amended in accordance with the observations made in the Evaluation Form; not publishing the manuscript.

ADJURIS – **International Academic Publisher** encourages the publication of manuscripts with international relevance which present comparative researches, promote interdisciplinarity in the social sciences, combine theoretical with empirical analysis within some case studies and benefit from a solid bibliographic base.
