Biography

Professor Danilo ČUPIĆ

He was born on September 25, 1983 in Cetinje.

He completed elementary and high school in Podgorica.

He graduated from the Faculty of Law, University of Montenegro in Podgorica in 2007, with an average grade of 9.47.

He enrolled in doctoral studies at the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade - constitutional law department, in 2008, where he defended his doctoral dissertation on the topic „Assessment of the Constitutionality of Acts and Actions of the Judicial Branch” in 2014.

He began his work immediately after graduating, in 2007, first as a teaching associate and then as an assistant at the Faculty of Law of the Mediterranean University, at the Department of Public Law, in the subjects Constitutional Law, Administrative Law, Human Rights and Judicial Organizational Law. In March 2015, he was elected to the scientific title of assistant professor at the Faculty of Law of the Mediterranean University, in the legal-political group of subjects: Administrative Law, Introduction to Large Legal Systems and Judicial Organizational Law. In 2020, he was elected to the title of associate professor. He is a lecturer at the Police Academy in Danilovgrad, in the subjects: Constitutional Law and Administrative Law, and previously also in the subject Business Law at the Faculty of Business Studies of the Mediterranean University. He held the positions of Vice-Dean for Education, Finance and International Cooperation at the Faculty of Law and Secretary of Master's Studies.

By the Decision of the Government of Montenegro dated 23.02.2017 he was appointed Acting Director General of the Directorate for Supervision in the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Government of Montenegro, and by the Decision dated 13.04.2017. as Director General of the Directorate of the same name, in which position he will remain until 16.10.2020. He was a member of the Bureau for Operational Coordination of Activities of the Intelligence and Security Sector Bodies of the Government of Montenegro; he was the President of the Interdepartmental Working Group of the Government of Montenegro for Monitoring the Implementation of the Schengen Action Plan, he was the President of the Interdepartmental Working Group of the Government of Montenegro for Drafting the New Law on Internal Affairs, as well as the Working Groups for Reorganization and Drafting Regulations and Other Acts Related to Changing the Work Methodology in the Police Administration. He was a member of the working group for negotiations with the EU for Chapter 23. He was previously a member of the examination committee for taking the professional exam for work in state administration bodies, the committee for taking the professional exam for performing security tasks and the committee for taking the

professional exam for critical infrastructure managers.

In the period from 2020-2023 assigned to the position Head of the Direction for Security and Supervision, Directorate for Security and Supervision of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Montenegro, whose scope of work includes supervision of the work of the Police Directorate. Since 2024, he has been a chief police advisor in the office of the Director of the Police Directorate.

He is the Vice President of the Young Lawyers' Council, the Lawyers' Association of Montenegro. He is a member of the initiative committee for the formation of the Network of Public Policy Evaluators of Montenegro (MECG). He is an associate of the Public Law Center Fund from Sarajevo. Montenegrin legal expert on the European Commission's Erasmus+ Project 573997-EPP-1 2016-1-ME-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP - Enhancement of study programs in Public Health Law, Health Management, Health Economics and Health Informatics in Montenegro (PHELYM); Member of the Steering Committee of the second phase of the "Project for Combating Economic Crime in Montenegro" (HF2-AEC-MNE) (2019-2020); Legal expert of the Human Resources Administration of the Government of Montenegro in the field of application of the Law on Administrative Procedure and the Law on Civil Servants and State Employees; Expert of the Training Center for the Judiciary and Prosecutor's Office of Montenegro, in the areas of: Human Rights, Administrative Law, Judicial Organizational Law; Member of the Association of Security Managers of Montenegro; Deputy Editor-in-Chief of the scientific and professional journal for theory and practice in the field of security - Montenegrin Security Review; Lecturer in the training programs of the Human Resources Administration on the Ready4EU project on the topics: Building European integration processes, European administrative space; Legal nature of the EU; Fundamental human rights and freedoms in the European Union, etc.
