THEMES OF CONFERENCE

Technological innovation is driving the reshaping of the economy and the transformation of law. The conference is a debate platform that examines the legal implications of the use of artificial intelligence and recent developments in the financial services industry under the impact of new digital technologies. The conference opens its doors to people from different countries, from the legal university environment and from among legal practitioners, encouraging the support of both scientific papers of international interest having as their object the law of financial technologies, cyberspace

The authors have the opportunity to submit a second scientific paper at the Conference paying an additional fee of 70 EUR.
