

The AJURIS Template for Conference Proceedings

I. Themes

We publish conference proceedings in **English** or **French**, selected based on their contribution to the **European and international doctrinal debate** on issues within the **social sciences** and **transdisciplinarity**. ADJURIS – **International Academic Publisher** encourages the publication of conference proceedings with **international relevance**, presenting **comparative research**, promoting **interdisciplinarity** within the social sciences, combining **theoretical and empirical analysis** through case studies, and benefiting from a **solid bibliographic foundation**.

II. Structure of the Manuscript

First page:

Editor(s). The first and last name of the editor(s) should be written in **Times New Roman 12**, aligned to the **right**, in **bold**, preceded by academic rank and scientific title (if applicable). The **family name** will be written in **capital letters**. The name should be followed by an indication of the main **institutional affiliation** (for each editor separately, if applicable) and **email address**, written in **Times New Roman 12, bold, italic**. Each editor must provide their **ORCID number**.

Title of the Conference Proceedings. The title should be written in **capital letters, Times New Roman 14, bold, centred**.

Second page:

Presentation of Editor(s). Please provide a brief description of academic **studies, activities, publications, awards, and prizes**.

Third page:

Presentation of the Conference Proceedings. The presentation should be **150-200 words**, written in **Times New Roman 12, italic, justified**. It must include:

- **Conference details** (web page, date, venue, edition);
- **Evaluation method** for the scientific papers included in the volume;
- **Section structure** of the volume;
- **Target audience**.

Keywords. Provide **4-6 keywords** that capture the essence of the conference proceedings, written in **Times New Roman 12, italic, justified**.

JEL Classification. After the keywords, please indicate the classification of the conference proceedings in one or more categories in the [JEL Classification](#) .

Table of Contents

The scientific papers included in the volume will be grouped by thematic sections. The table of contents will include: the titles of the sections, the titles of the scientific works, and the names of the authors.

III. Requirements Regarding the Form of Each Scientific Paper

Title of the Scientific Paper. The title is written in **capital letters, Times New Roman 14, bold, centred.**

Author(s). The first and last name of the author(s) should be written in **Times New Roman 12, aligned to the right, in bold, double-spaced** under the title, preceded by academic rank and scientific title (if applicable). The **family name** will be written in **capital letters**. The name will be followed by an indication of the main **institutional affiliation** (for each author separately, if applicable) and **email address**, written in **Times New Roman 12, bold, italic**. Each author will indicate their **ORCID number**.

Abstract. The abstract will have **150-200 words** and will be written in **Times New Roman 12, italic, justified**, two lines under the author's name. The abstract will include: objectives of the study, the research methods used, results, and implications of the study.

Keywords. **4-6 keywords** that comprise the essence of the scientific papers must be mentioned **two lines under the abstract, in Times New Roman 12, italic, justified**.

JEL Classification. After the keywords, please indicate the classification of the scientific papers in one or more categories in the [JEL Classification](#) .

Paper Body. The text will be written in **Times New Roman 12, justified, single-line spacing**. The scientific papers will be divided into **sections, each with a heading**. The **introductory section** will include:

- Identification of the problem investigated,
- Novelty compared to existing doctrinal approaches,
- Research structure,
- Explanation of research methods used,
- Proposed solutions.

The scientific papers will then include **sections related to the research and discussion** of the analysed topic.

At the end of the scientific papers, a **section of conclusions** shall be inserted, presenting research results and ways to apply them.

Footnotes. The footnotes should use **Times New Roman 9, justified, single-line spacing**. The footnotes will start with **number 1 on each page**. All quoted works and jurisprudence should be mentioned **only in footnotes**. The citations will be made according to [The Chicago Manual of Style](#), in **full format, not shortened notes**. In the case of jurisprudence, the document's name must be mentioned, along with its number, the date of ruling/issuance, the issuing authority (court), and the publication where it is included (**the Official Gazette, case law reports, etc.**).

Bibliography. A **bibliographic list** of the works used must be inserted at the end of the scientific papers. The list must include **all doctrinal sources** (books, articles) found in the footnotes throughout the scientific papers. The bibliographic list cannot include other doctrinal sources than

those used in the article and found in the footnotes. The indication of the works in the bibliographic list will be done according to [The Chicago Manual of Style](#). The titles of the works in the bibliographic list will be indicated **in the language in which they were published** and translated into **English in square brackets []**.

IV. Page Layout

The book has to be written in **Word**, using **A4 format (margins: top/bottom/left/right – 2 cm)**. The pages will be numbered with **Arabic numerals**, continuously, from the first to the last page.
